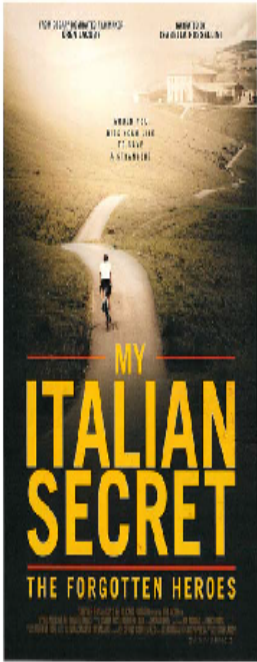
And I know that is ultimately my job here at Holy Family.
