

Dear Friends.

I'm excited to announce that St. Kevin Church is beginning to use *FlockNote*, a way for our parish to keep in touch with parishioners via email and text message. You might remember that we collected a lot of data in anticipation of the Generations of Faith Campaign. While we have recorded that information, there is no easy way to use it to send out messages to parishioners, whether by text or email. FlockNote makes it easy for parishioners to be arranged by groups so that notifications can go out either to a particular committee or ministry or to everyone who is enrolled. FlockNote generates the database of email addresses and cell phone numbers so that the information can be used immediately. Please bring your smart phone to Mass next weekend so we can explain the process to sign up.

The 2016 Annual Catholic Appeal will soon come to an end. As you know, in the past we generally surpassed the goal by \$10,000, which was then returned back to the parish for our operating expenses.
