From the Pastor's Desk....



Dear Parishioners,

I share with you Bishop DiMarzio's Cautions and Preventative Measures Regarding Coronavirus and the Flu. It is very strongly suggested that Holy Communion be received only in the hand, not on the tongue. The distribution of the Precious Blood is suspended for the time being. All ministers involved in the Liturgy will disinfect their hands, especially prior to Holy Communion. The exchange of a sign of peace is suspended for the time being. Holy Water fonts, doors and pews will be disinfected regularly. No one should feel obligated to use Holy Water or to greet others with a handshake. If you feel sick you should stay home until better. This over abundance of caution and commonsense measures should not frighten or lessen our unity as a community but enable us to assemble for worship in peace of mind. Let us pray for those who are sick with heartfelt compassion.

Laudato Si - Care for our Common Home

Turtles and plastic bags-Plastic bags can look like jellyfish, a common food source for turtles. Plastics kill around 100 million marine animals. Turtles cannot regurgitate plastic bags when they devour them. Ingested plastic bags cause gas bubbles inside the turtle, so they have great difficulty swimming. NY is now moving towards saving marine life by its new law banning the use of plastic bags.

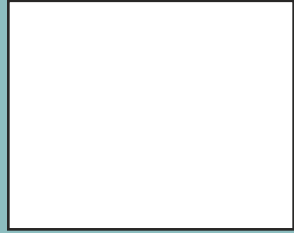
