the Rectory.

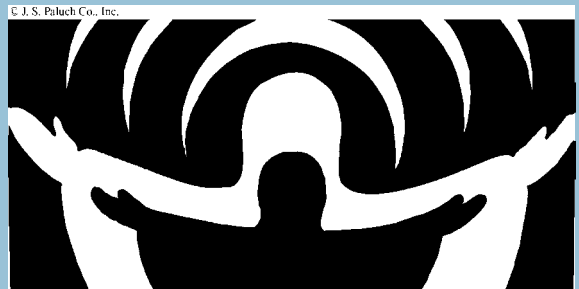

Manura: Teach, Govern, and Sanctify

Parish Mission, coming in March! It has been a number of years since our parish has had a mission. A parish is supposed to have a mission at least every ten years according to Church Law. Many older churches have what is called a "Mission Crucifix" which has the dates of previous mission etched on it. Our Mission Crucifix is the large one found in the Baptistry of our church. On the plaque you can read "Pamiętka Sw. Mysji" which is Polish for "In memory of the holy mission". It has dates for missions done in November, 1935 and March, 1941. The parish has had other missions but the practice of marking the plaque was not kept up. Fr. Ronan Murphy, a priest of our diocese, who works in the ministry of preaching Parish Missions will come to St. Josaphat's to preach at all the weekend Masses of March 7 & 8 and will preach each evening of March 9-11 in the evening with Exposition and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. As the dates come closer more information will be made available to you.

In our parishes the faithful generally hear the thoughts of the priests assigned to the parish and to be honest, each priest has his certain themes and ideas which all of his thoughts pass through. The purpose of a Parish Mission is to bring a preacher in who will stir the hearts, minds, and souls of the parish family including the priests of the parish too!

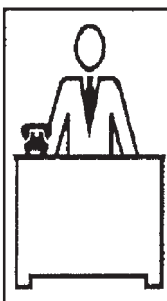
