sions are required for all couples.

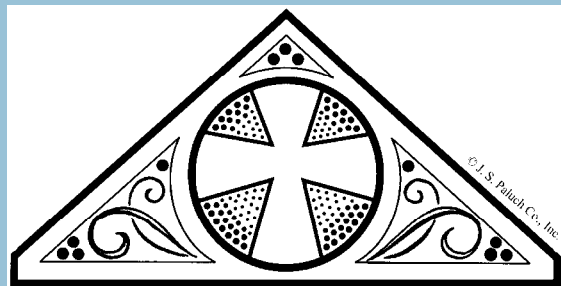

Lenten Regulations 2020

In the hope of assisting the faithful of the Diocese of Brooklyn to celebrate this season of preparation for Easter in a fruitful manner, Bishop Nicholas DiMarzio wishes to call attention to the following:

ABSTINENCE: *All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday (February 26, 2020) and on all the Fridays of the Lenten Season.*

FASTING: *All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 (inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday (April 10, 2020) by limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken at two other occasions during the day.*

EASTER DUTY: *After having been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, the faithful are obligated to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, this precept to be fulfilled during the Easter Season, unless it is fulfilled at some other time for a good reason. In the United States the period for fulfilling this precept is extended from the First Sunday of Lent (March 1, 2020) until Pentecost Sunday (May 31, 2020).*

THE SOLEMNITIES OF SAINT JOSEPH AND THE ANNUNCIATION OF THE LORD: *The liturgical solemnities of Saint Joseph (March 19, 2020) and the Annunciation of the Lord (March 25, 2020) are to be celebrated with due solemnity even though they fall within the Season of Lent.*

RECONCILIATION MONDAY: *Reconciliation Monday is observed in the Diocese on the Monday of Holy Week (April 6, 2020). Observance of this day allows the faithful to experience the grace of forgiveness and mercy in the Sacrament of Penance. Those conscious of grave (mortal) sin are obligated to confess before receiving Holy Communion.*

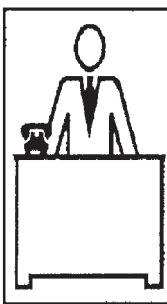
