Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I just want to inform you that on January 3, 2018, The Board of Directors of the Divine Wisdom Catholic Academy (DWCA) officially announced that they will consolidate two campuses, Douglaston and Bayside, into one. They will close the Bayside campus as of June, 2018, and merge with the Douglaston campus.

The Board presented several reasons for the merger. Among them, one major reason was the low enrollment of students in the Bayside campus. Due to that factor, it was not financially viable for them to maintain two campuses.

What impact does this merger have us?

With the closing of Bayside campus, our school building will be open as to receive a new tenant. I'm working with the Financial Council of our parish along with the Real Estate agent of our Diocese, to find a suitable tenant who can occupy our school building. If we can find a good tenant, the income generated from this lease will be financially beneficial for our parish.

I want you to be aware that the closing of the Bayside campus does not mean that our parish is closing.

Please note that this merger does not affect or change the liturgical and sacramental life of our parish. We will continue to have our **Masses** and will continue to have the **Religious Education Program** for our children in the parish. I realize that the merger of DWCA is a major change for our parish, and changes are not easy to accept by any means. It can rattle us and throw us off guard. My dear parishioners, as your Pastor, I'd like to make one earnest request. Please keep your morale high and stay united as a parish of St. Robert Bellarmine. Many things can discourage us and rob us of our hopes. However, when we stay positive and trust that our Lord will guide us in the right direction, good things will come to our parish.

As we deal with these changes, may I ask you to join me in asking for the intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary, St. Robert Bellarmine and Korean Martyrs, for guidance and strength through this time of transition.
