



The billions of items of plastic waste that are choking our oceans, lakes and rivers and piling up on land is more than unsightly and harmful to plants and wildlife.

- About 8 million metric tons of plastic are thrown into the ocean annually. Of those, 236,000 tons are microplastics - tiny pieces of broken-down plastic smaller than your little fingernail.

- ♦ There are 5 massive patches of plastic in the oceans around the world. These huge concentrations of plastic debris cover large swaths of the ocean; the one between California and Hawaii is the size of the state of Texas.
- Every minute, one garbage truck of plastic is dumped into our oceans.
