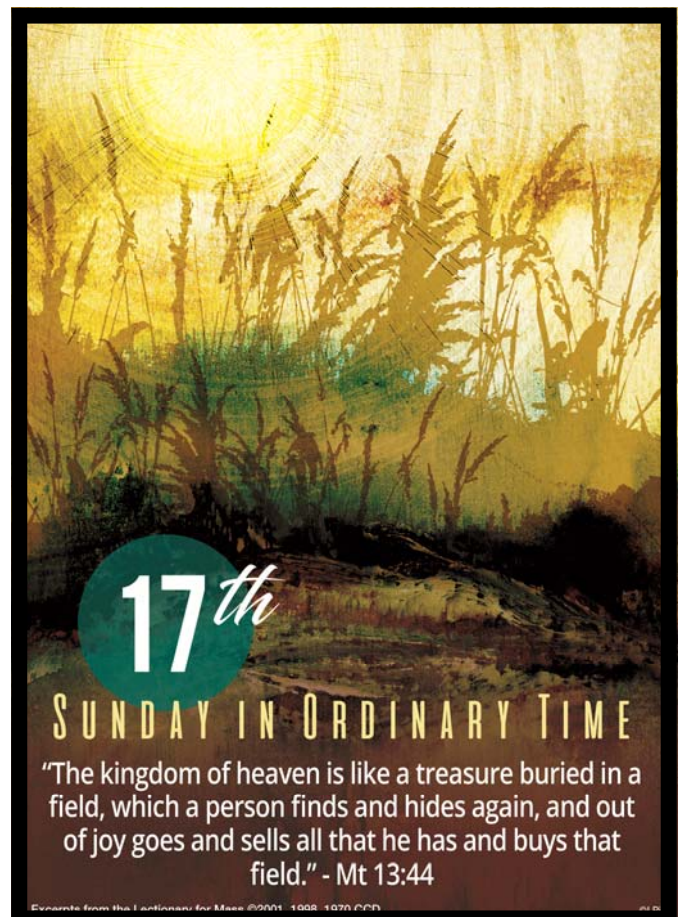

### Eucharistic Adoration:

Baptism: Instruction classes are held on the *last Saturday* of each month in the rectory at 11 AM. Parents should call the rectory to make arrangements before they attend the class and bring with them a copy of the child's birth certificate. Baptism is administered on the **2nd Sunday** of every month at **1:30 PM**.

Confession / Reconciliation: Saturday: 4:00 PM to 4:45 PM or by appointment with one of the priests.

Marriage: A couple must come to the rectory to make arrangements for their wedding **at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding date**. Please call the rectory to make an appointment. ## INTINCTION

Intinction is the practice of the minister offering Holy Communion by dipping the consecrated host (the Body of Christ) into the precious Blood and then placing it on the tongue of the communicant. A plate is always used underneath to prevent any spilling. Note that the communicant is never the one to do this, only the minister. This form is not the preferred practice in the U.S. Your only option is to drink from the chalice or not. Remember that while receiving under both forms has a greater sign value, we do receive the entire Christ, Body and Blood, when we receive either species.
