FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I regret to inform you that Father Timothy Hirten (Major USAF), a former parochial vicar here at Sacred Heart, died on Sunday, August 16. Please remember to pray for the repose of Father Tim's soul and for the gift of peace and consolation for his family. Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. Amen. May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace. Amen.

There will be a special collection for the people of Beirut, Lebanon next weekend, August 29th & 30th. If you attend Mass in person a special basket will be marked for your donations for this purpose. If you attend Mass via live stream you may send your donation in the mail and please make sure you write that it is for the people of Beirut, Lebanon on your check or enclose a note stating that this donation is for that purpose. You cannot donate for this cause on WeShare (on-line giving) since it is a response to a particular situation namely, the disastrous explosion in Beirut a few weeks ago. Please remember the people of Lebanon in your prayers. May God bless you for your generosity.

I have been informed by Bishop DiMarzio that he is assigning a retired priest of the Diocese, Father James Meszaros, to be "in residence" in our rectory. Father James is the Pastor Emeritus of St. Stanislaus Bishop and Martyr Parish in Ozone Park and has been living for the past few years in residence at St. Josaphat's. Please join me in welcoming Father James to our parish community.

Please consider saying the Rosary or at least one decade of the Rosary for all our doctors, nurses, hospital personnel and support staff, police officers, firefighters, EMS/EMT personnel, and all other essential workers who are truly heroes. May God bless them through Our Lady's intercession for their selfless acts of love and charity on our behalf.

Thanks to all who have returned their updated parish census forms to the rectory. If you have not done so as of yet please do as soon as possible. You can mail them, drop them off in the rectory mail slot or send them via email. Even if you have

filled out a census form in the past PLEASE fill out the one sent in the mail or print it online. We are trying to update our parish data base.

Please check our parish webpage and FaceBook page for updates and important announcements.

You can watch Mass on TV or livestreamed from our own church by going to the webpage <https://sacredheartbayside-queens.org> and clicking on the "Watch Mass Stream" button. The Mass will also be available to be viewed "on demand".

Masses are being celebrated weekdays and on Sundays. We are allowed to have 25% of our capacity in church at one time. We can have 65 people at each Mass. The rules of social distancing will be strictly adhered to and it is required that masks be worn at all times except when receiving Communion. Families (meaning you all live in the same household) will be able to sit together in designated pews.

The church will not be open until approximately 15 minutes before the Mass is scheduled to begin so that proper sanitizing can take place between each Mass. Once our allowed capacity is reached no one will be permitted to enter the church. Please cooperate with the greeters and understand that this is for the safety and well-being of everyone.

The Sunday Mass schedule will be as follows: Saturday, at 5pm and Sundays at 8:00am, 10:00am and 12 Noon. At the present, there will not be a Sunday evening Mass at 5:00pm.

After Mass, please refrain from applause and exit the church quickly so that the church can be sanitized before the next service begins.

We still need greeters/ushers especially for the Saturday 5pm Mass to ensure that the guidelines of the CDC are being followed—i.e. that people are seated in the spots measured out using social distancing guidelines, making sure people are wearing masks, that we only have the amount of people allowed in the church at a given time, to ensure the six feet space between people especially when approaching the altar to receive Holy Communion. If you can help in these matters please call Monsignor Machalski at 718-428-2200.

If you are ill, have a medical issue or are in any way compromised please stay home.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday was dispensed by the Bishop at the outset of the Pandemic and still remains in effect.

With the change in Mass schedule please note that if you have requested Masses for an intention, they are being satisfied but perhaps at a different time than when you arranged for the Mass. The Saturday, 5:00pm Mass is not affected by this change. The intentions and Mass time remain the same.

Mass Intentions originally requested for Sunday 9:30am are being fulfilled at the 8:00 am Mass on Sunday.

Mass Intentions originally requested as part of the Collective Mass at 11:30am are being fulfilled at the 10:00am Mass.

Mass Intentions originally requested for Sunday at 5:00pm are being fulfilled at the 12:00 pm Mass.

Thank you for your understanding as we try to adjust to a "new normal" due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

If you desire a worship aid to use during Mass and, since we cannot use missalettes you can purchase a missalette at the rectory for \$2.00 that you can bring back and forth with you to Church. 
