Brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we begin a new school year, I just want to welcome you back. I hope you had an enjoyable and restful summer. I would like to bring your attention at this time to the Mass time changes that will be in effect as we begin a new fiscal year.

As you may know, our Korean Mass which begins at 9:15 AM usually lasts more than an hour and finishes around 10:30 AM. Certainly many factors are involved but the principal factor is the large amount of people attending that particular Mass. About 450 to 500 people attend that Mass and it was affecting the subsequent Masses. Hence, upon consulting our pastoral staff, I've decided to move the times of the subsequent Masses 15 minutes ahead.

Specifically, 10:45 AM Mass will now be at 11 AM, 12:15 PM Mass will now be at 12:30 PM. These changes will begin on the weekend of October 8, 2017.

Although it's only 15 minutes, I think it will resolve some of the parking issues that we've been having due to the overlap of Masses.

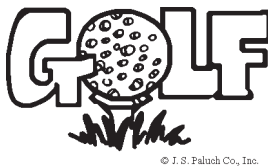
