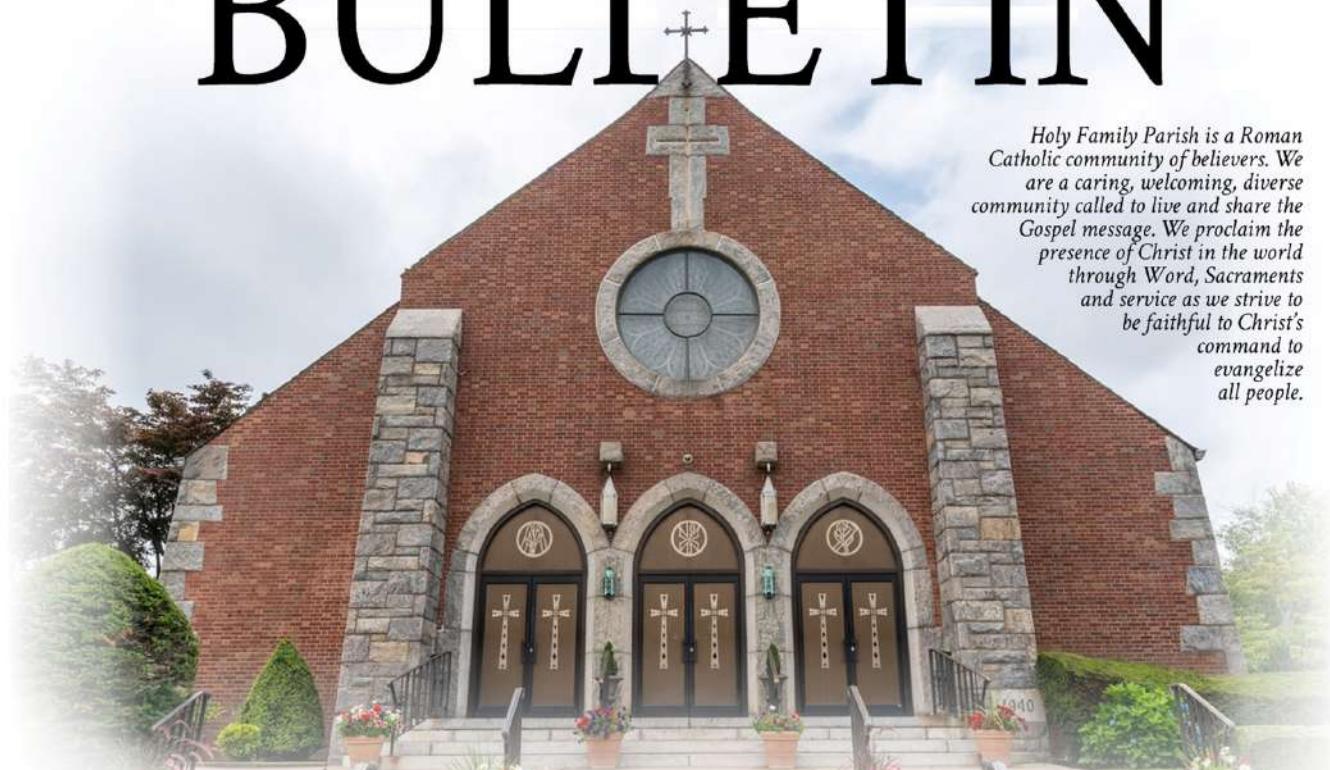


# Holy Family Parish BULLETIN

### **Synod 2023: Communion, Participation and Mission**

Throughout the papacy of Pope Francis, he has expressed a desire to strengthen the unity, collegiality and inclusivity of Church governance on matters of faith and morals and life in the Church. On April 24 of this current year, Pope Francis announced the convocation of the Sixteenth Ordinary Synod --- originally scheduled for 2022 but postponed due to the pandemic until 2023 --- with the theme “For A Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission,” It will follow a newly revised synod process. The Holy Father wants individual dioceses around the world to gather input and ideas on synodality, or processes for collaboration, from local clergy, women religious, and laypeople. So there will be a participation on the local level. I am waiting to hear how that will work in our diocese.

### **Bishop Robert Brennan will be installed the Eighth Bishop of Brooklyn**

His Installation will be on Tuesday, November 30th. As a parish we give thanks to Almighty God for Bishop DiMarzio’s 18 years of ministry and leadership in Brooklyn and we offer him our sincere congratulations! Bishop Robert Brennan was a priest of the Diocese of Rockville Centre and was appointed Auxiliary Bishop in June 2012. He served as the Vicar General of the diocese for many years. He was later named the 12<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Columbus, Ohio. We look forward to welcoming Bishop Brennan as our new Shepherd to Holy Family in the future.

### **ACA Update**

As of October 12th , 216 parishioners/individuals have already pledged \$105,217.00 to the 2021 ACA and \$86,814.20 has been paid. We still have \$4,567.79 in pledged monies to be fulfilled. 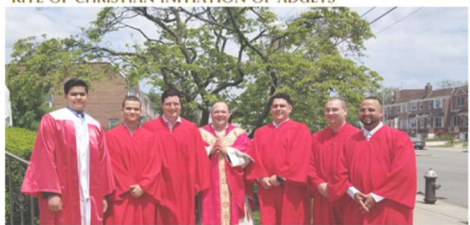
